The Dandelion

The golden blossom of the dandelion lives the sun. It only opens up when the sun rises. It closes when it is cloudy or dark. Sometimes there are little stars that fly off in the wind. At other times you may just see green dandelion leaves with sharply pointed spines. If you look at a dandelion throughout the year, you may see how it changes during the seasons.

How The Dandelion Changes
